Relationships and Health Education Curriculum

You will recall, following a period of consultation with parents and other stakeholders, we have adopted the Jigsaw curriculum through which we will deliver the statutory RSHE [Relationships, (Sex) and Health Education] curriculum. A copy of the school's policy for the delivery of this content can be found on the [school website](#).

Although the government put back the start date for delivery of the statutory content, we made the decision to implement the scheme from September 2020. Despite the period of lockdown in the Spring Term, teachers were still able to deliver the majority of the content planned to date.

For this reason, over the course of the Summer Term, all four year groups will now cover the units of work entitled **Relationships** and **Changing Me**. Both these units will cover aspects of the statutory Science curriculum as well, looking at the human life cycle and body changes. Details of the specific content and the vocabulary covered can be found under the [Curriculum Section](#) of the school website, which in turn is broken up into the four year groups.

Different year groups will cover the content at different times and also in different ways. It may be appropriate, for example, to block lessons to have a slightly longer session to cover some of the areas.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that this content is now being covered. No action is required on your part.
